The City of Cape Town invites residents and affected stakeholders to comment on the Draft Movable Heritage Assets Collection Policy.

- The policy seeks to safeguard the objects' value, allow for the continued study of components of Cape Town's history and define objectives for developing the collection into the future.
- The policy will give guidance on how the objects, entrusted to the municipality, will be conserved for the benefit of current and future generations.
- The policy seeks to give guidance on how the collection can be made available to the public, through exhibitions, programmes, publications, loans, etc.

In terms of section 17 of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act, Act 32 of 2000, the public and interested parties or groups given the opportunity to submit comments, recommendations or input to the municipality from 2 March 2020 until 2 April 2020.
